The United Way of Greater High Point mobilizes the business community, volunteers, and its 29 local partner agencies to develop resources and partnerships that address critical human service needs in our community. Our focus is on Education, Income/Financial Stability, and Health, because these are the “building blocks” for a good quality of life for each of us. United Way-funded programs help children learn and families thrive, build self-sufficiency and independence, create stronger and safer neighborhoods, and improve the health of our communities.

OUR GOALS

INVESTING IN EDUCATION

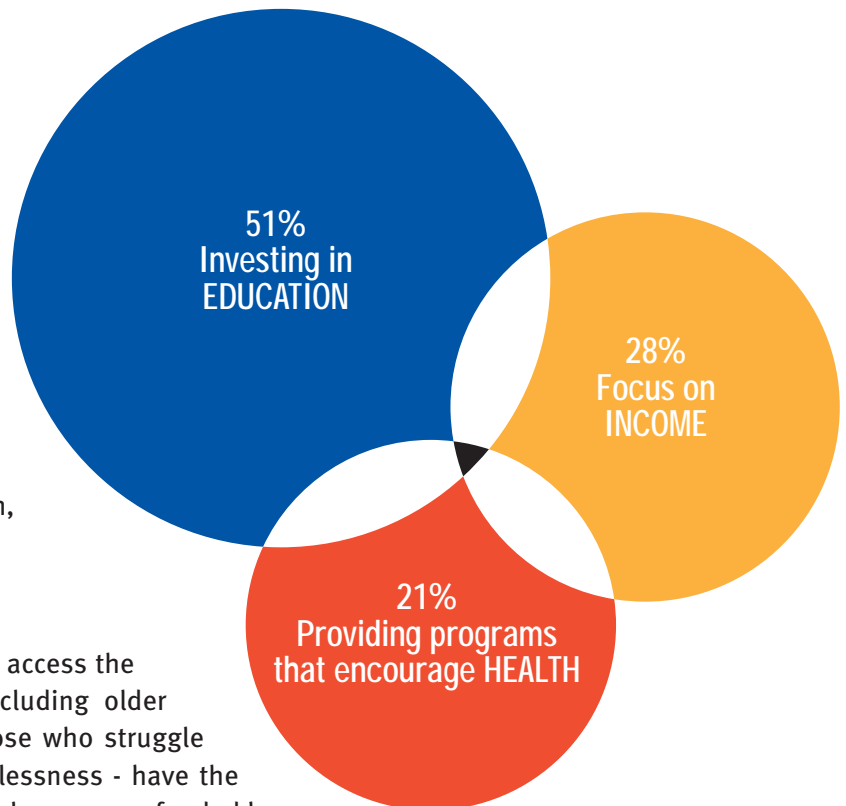
Our goals: Children are prepared for success in school and in life. Families have the tools they need to successfully meet the challenges of parenting. High quality youth development and mentoring programs are available to keep at-risk kids on track to high school graduation – and beyond. Nearly half of United Way’s funding helps children and youth, because most donors tell us that this is their biggest priority. There are many United Way funded-programs serving children and youth, thanks to our donors’ generous support.

FOCUS ON INCOME / FINANCIAL STABILITY

Our goals: People in crisis or transition successfully access the community resources they need. Individuals – including older adults and people with disabilities - as well as those who struggle with unemployment, under-employment, and homelessness - have the potential to live as independently as possible, through programs funded by donations to United Way. Approximately 14.8% of people in Guilford County live in poverty, including many families, older adults, and children. In 2010, a national study identified Guilford County fourth in the nation in the area of “food hardship,” experienced by 24.9% of local households. Fortunately, those are statistics we can potentially change. 28% of local United Way dollars goes towards helping people become more financially-stable and self-sufficient.

PROVIDING PROGRAMS THAT ENCOURAGE HEALTH

Our goals: An individual’s potential to be physically, mentally, and emotionally well is fully-realized. Families are strengthened and cases of child abuse and neglect are reduced. Approximately 29% of Guilford County residents don’t have health insurance. 11% of these are children. Many residents of our community have health issues, or are at-risk of developing them. 26% of UWGHP’s funding is allocated towards improving the health of people in our community.

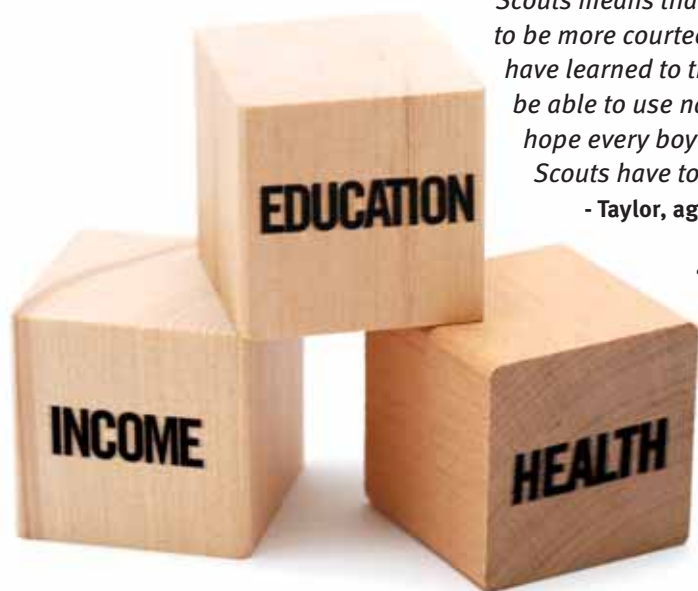

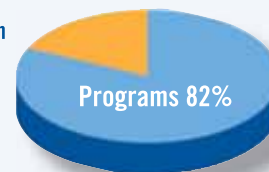

Through a partnership with Second Harvest Food Bank, our BackPack Program feeds **250** elementary school students at-risk for hunger over the weekends.

189 people have graduated - so far - from Project Board Development, a leadership development program developed by United Way of Greater High Point. It is designed to identify, recruit, and train multi-cultural candidates for referral to serve on committees and governing boards of local health and human service organizations.



44,140 pounds of food were collected by local letter carriers in Greater High Point on May 14th to benefit the food pantries at 14 local agencies. The combined total for 2011 is significantly above last year's total of 36,030 pounds collected.



The United Way of Greater High Point is the major distributor of the FamilyWize prescription drug discount card in High Point. Approximately **4,000** people in the Greater High Point area have saved over **\$63,000** in medication costs over the past three years using this card. The Caremark prescription drug card, distributed in partnership with the City of High Point, is also available at UWGHP and at many other area locations.



65 homeless kids, including some from United Way partner agencies such as The Salvation Army, Youth Unlimited, and Family Service of the Piedmont, received toys and books through United Way's "Gifts for Homeless Kids."

In early 2011 the United Way of Greater High Point concluded its 2010 fund-raising campaign, announcing a total raised of **\$4,400,375**. The campaign was chaired by Randy Brodd with Dixon Hughes Goodman LLP.

According to results reported to United Way of North Carolina, Greater High Point has posted the best campaign results among the major United Ways in the state for the third time in the last four years. The one time during that span in which Greater High Point wasn't first in that group, it was second. The major United Ways include metropolitan Charlotte, as well as Asheville, Greensboro, Forsyth County, the Triangle, and Wilmington.

Old Dominion Freight Line, Inc. was the top contributor in the 2010 United Way campaign with a total gift of \$281,801, including employee and corporate giving. This was a 6% increase over 2009. The City of High Point was the second largest donor with a total of \$255,764.

Other large donors include Bank of America – Triad Center, Sealy, High Point Regional Health System, High Point Bank &

Trust, New Breed Logistics, Thomas Built Buses, Guilford County Schools, Dixon Hughes Goodman LLP, Banner Pharmacaps, Cornerstone Healthcare, Aetna, and High Point University.

Companies posting large increases in 2010 giving include Thomas Built Buses, Inc., Cross Company, High Point University, Kao Specialties Americas LLC, Ilderton Dodge Chrysler Jeep, Bank of North Carolina, Banner Pharmacaps, Inc., New Breed Logistics, and Vann York Auto Group.

In the 2010 campaign, the United Way of Greater High Point is also honored to have 64 members of the Alexis de Tocqueville Society, which raised \$768,000 in gifts of \$10,000 each or more. By comparison, in the 2009 campaign, UWGHP's Tocqueville Society had 61 members that contributed \$729,772.

SPIRIT OF NORTH CAROLINA AWARDS

In February 2011, the United Way of North Carolina awarded the prestigious “Spirit of North Carolina” Awards to companies and organizations with outstanding United Way campaigns, including four from the Greater High Point area: High Point University, Kirkman Park Elementary School, Kao Specialties Americas, and Steelcase were lauded for their support of United Way and their exemplary fund-raising campaigns in 2010.

ALEXIS DE TOCQUEVILLE SOCIETY AWARDS
